# STRATEGY OF THE MONTH

### Informal Mediations

The skills you learn as a TAP mediator are not restricted to formal mediations. You can also help your peers during downtime at school, on the bus, at practice, or at home. Here are some tips to keep in mind:

 You are not there to give advice, but to help the disputants think through

- questions to the root of the conflict and find a win-win solution.
- Make both people feel like they are being heard.
  If the conflict is too hig to resolve in an
- If the conflict is too big to resolve in an informal setting, refer the disputants to a formal mediation.
- Remember to maintain confidentiality.
